

CPL Gamer League Application

About the League

The CPL Gamer League is a local Esports league for teens between the age of 13 and 18. The League is made up of teams of four players, plus an optional manager, who compete during a season. Throughout the season each team competes in different Esport events. Wins provide a team with two points, ties reward a single point, and a loss provides no points. At the end of each season the top teams will compete in the End Game Tournament to determine the champion for that season.

Events will be tailored to each team role. As an added challenge teams will need to be aware of the lineup of events. This is important because each player goes on a 2 round cooldown after playing a round regardless of their role. This means other players will need to compete in the coming rounds before the player on cooldown can return.

Teams Roles

Brawler. The brawler never backs down from a challenge. These players know the combos and when to use them. They excel in direct competition, ready to counter their opponent at every move. They enjoy the direct challenge that other players provide. To them PVP is what it is all about.

Racer. If you find yourself saying, "Speed. I am speed," then you are a racer. Racers are the fastest of the fast and this applies to everything. They think fast, they move fast, and they love it. A racer does more than racing games, they enjoy speed challenge. Adaptive and quick, no one catches them.

Survivor. Before the zombies can even come out the first night the survivor is fully geared and in a castle. These players enjoy exploration and the challenges that come from it. Singular challenges are not for the survivor. They are masters at adaptation and they require games that can keep them on their toes.

Wild Card. This gamer is the Jack of all trades. They like everything about gaming and they don't back down from anything. They may not be as focused as other gamers in their play styles but this their strength. If life had classes like games do the Wild Card is the hybrid, the rangers, druids, and shamans.

NPC. (Optional) The NPC is exactly that, a non-playing character. They are social by nature and they love interacting with players. Ready to give out a quest at any moment the NPC organizes the players activities. They tell them where to go and what 10 items to collect. After all, without the NPC there is no game.

Rules and Regulations

All participants must read and agree to the following rules and regulations:

Good Sportsmanship Guidelines

- **Play fair.** Fair play is an important part of the league. Cheating will not be tolerated in any form. The league is a competition of skills and any aspect of play that provides a player with an unfair advantage will not be tolerated. Cheating will result in expulsion from the league.
- **Be a team player.** The league is designed to bring players of different backgrounds into a fun and exciting competition. As such all players are expected to be respectful of their teammates and other competitors. All competitors are expected to be respectful at all times and name calling, teasing, bullying, and any other example of poor sportsmanship will result in suspension or expulsion from the league. This guideline includes the described behaviors within and outside the library, including online.
- **Stay positive.** Having a positive attitude not only helps with performance in the competition, it will also keep you from breaching league rules.
- **Lose gracefully.** Losing can be hard, but it is important for all competitors to maintain their composure as good sportsmen. It isn't over until you decide it is over. We all have off days and we all run into someone who is better. If you have a bad day, come back stronger tomorrow or next season. If your opponent is better, rise to the challenge.
- **Win with class.** Winning is fun and exciting. However it is important to win with class. Remember not to gloat or mock your opponents. Enjoy the victory and let your skills do the talking.
- **Respect the ruling of officials.** Be it a library staff member or volunteer, arguing with officials will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to name calling, aggressive arguments over rulings, or a disrespectful attitude.

Library Code of Conduct

- Behavior must not disrupt other people's use of the library.
- Library patrons must be considerate of others in the library and treat other patrons and staff with courtesy and respect, honor other patrons' privacy and keep all conversations quiet.
- Any action recognized as illegal is prohibited in the library.
- Cell phones must be set to mute or vibrate in the library.
- Food and beverages may only be consumed in designated areas.
- If a person creates or emanates a detectable odor that disturbs other library patrons or staff, they will be asked to leave until the situation is corrected.
- Bicycles, skates, skateboards, collapsible scooters and other such items may not be used in library entryways or walkways and must be kept out of passageways.
- Smoking or use of tobacco products is not allowed in the library or on the patio in front of the library.
- The consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the premises except for special events that have obtained appropriate City approvals.
- Shopping carts are not allowed in the library.
- Animals are not allowed in the library, except those needed to assist disabled people.
- Library restrooms may not be used for bathing or washing clothing.
- Shoes must be worn in the library.
